

HOW TO CREATE SEEING STARS YOURSELF? - A short manual

- 1. Make an index of the most non-essential light polluters such as greenhouses, billboards, gas stations, etc.
- 2. Create 1 artistic impression which visualizes the impact of lights off, stars on. Preferable with an iconic building or location, and as realistic as possible.
- 3. Present it to the mayor or government in charge of the city or town. Convince them of the beauty and importance of seeing the stars. It's a collective effort which creates a new community experience, covid-proof.
- 4. Once the government is on board, start a communication campaign to encourage the community to participate, e.g. citizens, entrepreneurs, companies, institutions. Present it as being a community project in which everyone has to work together.
- 5. Weather heavily influences the visual experience, such as clouds, rain but also humidity in the air, which reflects the light pollution. Regularly check the weather forecast. Ideally, a non-cloudy, cold winter night is the best.
- 6. If possible, plan a general rehearsal night to check the visual impact and to see if all involved cooperate as promised. After that, set a final date for opening.
- 7. Please invite us to the opening!

It is a simple idea but needs the collective effort in order to work. So, make sure you have enough time to prepare, manage and communicate to encourage your city.
